Methods of National Tax Payment

In general, it is necessary that you pay your national tax by yourself based on the amount of your declaration by the due date.

For taxpayers, the following methods of national tax payment are available.



1. Direct Payment

You can pay the tax online via "*Direct Payment*" using e-Tax system. (Direct deduction from your bank account.)



2. Internet banking

You can pay the tax online using Internet banking.



3. Credit card

You can pay the tax by credit card via personal computer (PC) or mobile phone.

4. Convenience stores

You can pay the tax in cash with a Tax Payment Slip with bar code at convenience stores. (Only for tax payments of up to ¥300,000 in total amount per slip.)



5. Account transfer

You can pay the tax by automatic account transfer from the taxpayer's deposit/saving account on the payment due date.



6. Over-the-counter payment

You can pay the tax in cash with a Tax Payment Slip at the counters of financial institutions (banks, post offices, etc.) and your district tax office.

(Notes)

* If you pay your tax late, you will be liable to pay delinquent tax, which is calculated for the number of days starting from the day following the statutory due date for tax payment to the day on which the entire amount of the principal tax is paid.

* This also applies in cases bank transfer was delayed due to lack of funds or other reasons on the taxpayer's account.
