

2024 INCOME TAX

GUIDE

The filing period of your taxable income in the period of the calendar year 2024, is open;

**From February 17 (Mon.)
through March 17 (Mon.), 2025**

- You are advised that you file your final return and complete the payment **before March 17 (Mon.), 2025**, if you earn taxable income in the calendar year 2024, from January 1 to December 31.
- When you can receive a tax refund, the Tax Office accept your final return **before February 14 (Fri.), 2025**.

- NOTICE -

- ✓ If you have your Individual Number for Social Security and Tax (“My-Number”), you need to write your number in your return form. You also need to present your identification documents or attach copies of them. (see page 68)

【Example of identification documents】

e. g. 1 Individual Number Card (“My-Number Card”)

e. g. 2 Notification card of the Individual Number and Driver's license or Passport etc.
